Dear Parents and Carers,

A very warm welcome back to school after the Easter holiday. This half term is very short and busy, with plenty of exciting events to keep us all on our toes!!

Our overarching learning theme across the two schools is 'The Living World'. This is being adapted to suit the ages and curriculum requirements for children of different ages. Our Collective Worship / Assembly focus is 'Friendship'.



#### **SATs**

Next week, children in Year 6 across both schools will be involved with national SATs tests. The timetable is as follows:

Monday 8 <sup>th</sup> May	English reading
Tuesday 9 <sup>th</sup> May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 1: short answer questions English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 2: spelling
Wednesday 10 <sup>th</sup> May	Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic Mathematics Paper 2: reasoning
Thursday 11 <sup>th</sup> May -	Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

A very big thank you to Mr Howson and to Mrs Appleton for supporting the children in their preparation for the SATs tests.

We already feel very proud of all of the children in Year 6 for their very positive attitude towards their learning and we recognise that the test that the children will be taking next week are one small part of their 'learning journey'.

We realise that some of the children may feel a little nervous and that this is normal but we would like to reassure the children that they have every reason to be confident and approach the tests with calmness. It would be very helpful for the children if they could have a relaxing weekend ahead of the tests, where they can be well rested and mentally prepared for giving their best during next week.

Children in Year 6 are invited to bring in a small special 'treat' to eat at the end of each day's tests. Children across the school have some exciting learning to look forward to once the tests are all finished!!

During the w/b 15<sup>th</sup> May, children in Year 2 will be taking part in more formal assessments. We are required to administer the KS1 tests in English reading and mathematics during May 2017. The tests do not have set days for their administration, and they may be administered to groups of pupils on different days. We will seek to carry out the testing process for Year 2 in such a way that the children see the test as part of their normal day at school, wherever possible.

#### **RSE** week

During the w/b 22<sup>nd</sup> May, children in both schools will be taking part in a week where the focus is RSE (Relationship and Sex Education). Parents and carers of children in Year 5 and 6 were invited to attend an information drop-in session on 26<sup>th</sup> April, where information specific to this area of the curriculum for older primary school children was shared. If your child is currently in Year 5 and 6 you should also have received a letter, both a paper copy and emailed to you, which outlined the aspects of RSE. If you have not received a copy of this letter, please do contact the school office.



Children in Reception and Years 1-4, will also be taking part in some learning around relationship and sex education, appropriate to their age and stage of development. Should you wish to discuss anything relating to this week please do contact your child's teacher or Mrs Hartshorn, PSHE Leader (Personal, Social and Health Education). Mrs Hartshorn is based at Staveley and normally works on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

#### **Sports Day**

The framework for our annual Sports Day is currently being planned. We are hoping to be able to include some competitive races and also some athletics activities. More details to follow soon!

#### **Carnival of the Animals**

On the last day of the Spring term, children in both schools joined together at Staveley to listen to a musical version of The Selfish Dragon.
