Welcome back to the new academic year and hope you have all had a good summer and are rested for the term ahead. I am certainly looking forward to getting to know my new class.

The children have returned keen to begin our new topic "Movers and Shakers".

During Literacy we will be looking at labelling our time machine, writing instructions, and writing a report based on a famous inventor.

Our Maths sessions will begin with Number and Place Value.

Our Science this term will look at Materials and Seasonal Changes.

Our DT sessions will involve creating a time machine to enable us to travel back in time, designing our own parachutes, creating rubber band transportation and creating our own paper aeroplanes!

PE which will be taught on Mondays and Fridays. Please ensure PE kit is in school at the beginning of the week so we can be flexible. PE will be held outside if the weather is dry therefore layered clothing is ideal. It is also very important that the children bring in their water bottle each day.

In Religious Education we will look at Harvest, Diwali, Christingle, Advent and the Christmas Story as the term goes on.

Our Topic work will be History based focusing on Inventors including the Wright brothers and De Vinci.

Spelling checks will take place for all the children on Tuesdays and the children will receive new ones to learn for the following Tuesday. Homework books will need to be handed in every Monday and will be given out again every Wednesday.

It is always lovely to hear and share about the things that the children do at home or in things that inspire them. We will continue to do this whenever time allows.
